I, Jacob O Kamins, Special Prosecutor for Lane County, being sworn, say that the purposes of probation are not being served. I have read a report from Veronica Broadley, Investigations Coordinator at the Oregon Humane Society, which says the defendant has:

1. Failed to provide monthly digital pictures of each of The 4 horses sufficient to see overall body condition and hay and grain receipts to LCAS Officer Bernard Perkins.
2. Failed to make monthly restitution payments.

The State moves the Court for an order requiring the defendant to appear and show cause why the order of probation previously entered herein should not be revoked and sentence imposed, and that a bench warrant may issue herein. Probation is set to expire October 29, 2024.
