ADDENDUM TO JUDGEMENT


CHRISTY ANN HORTON,

Pursuant to the recommendation of the parties, and the Court having heard from the parties and being fully informed, the following conditions shall be terms of that probation in addition to those listed and identified in that (those) Judgement(s) for conviction in the above captioned matter:

- 1) Defendant is prohibited from owning, possessing, or having in her care, custody or control all animals of any genus for the duration of probation.
- 2) Defendant shall surrender ownership of all animals in the defendant's care, custody or control, as well as all animals impounded in EPD Case No. 22-14596, to include but not limited to three Great Dane Dogs: Teller, Maggie and Bandit.
- 3) Defendant shall fully comply with those requirements imposed upon Defendant pursuant to ORS 167.332, if and when those requirements apply to Defendant.
- 4) Defendant shall maintain care of animals on her property/properties in Lane County for a time period of 30 days, such time to commence upon the date of this judgment, in order to allow the City of Eugene to perform the safe and proper removal of animals from Defendant's property/properties in Lane County. Defendant must substantially comply in good faith with the directions of the City of Eugene/Animal Welfare Services in the City's performance of the safe and proper removal of animals from the property/properties in Lane County.
