

My only concern is that children run the facility so I'm not sure they're able to make the best decisions when it comes to the overall health of the horse and the safety of riders. That day I was paired with Jet and I realized that something was wrong when I

heard the two girls working there whispering and looking at each other. I asked one of them if Jet was okay to ride and she said yes that she was just sore. Once I got on Jet, I tried to calm her down by petting her and I could tell that she didn't want to go on the ride. She would fall behind and then trot to catch up probably making her injury worse. Again, throughout the ride I would pet her to make her feel reassured. By the end of the ride she was irritated and trying to fight other horses while I was on her and she walked towards her corral letting me know she was done for the day. I kept calm the entire time as I have had lessons prior but if an inexperienced rider would have been paired with her, it could've been a lot worse. I would give this place 5 stars but after looking back, I realized that the overall health of the horse should be a priority. I don't know much about horses or riding but putting someone on an injured horse is dangerous. Although this did happen, we still had a great time and would recommend it to family and friends.

I am glad you all had fun on your ride....I would like to assure you our horses are checked daily by the adults that bring the horses out and back home twice a day. We never ride our horses hurt. If they are cranky sometimes it is because they have good and bad days just like us. Jet has shown no signs of any injuries at any time. The ride was beautiful but the kids running the stable were incredibly unorganized. We left 40 minutes late and getting everyone on horses was chaotic. There were 2 - 7-10 year olds "helping" get people on horses which was potentially dangerous. No adults were around. 3 teenagers ran the ride and 2 of them argued and yelled at each other almost the entire time. The lead girl Alyssa tried to run things and seemed to know what she was doing but one of the boys Chris wouldn't follow her directions so they just screamed at each other. It made for an uncomfortable situation. I don't recommend it and regret spending over \$300 on a ride that my family didn't enjoy because of all the conflict, yelling, and disorganization.
