any of the dogs and that "JoJo" and "Ukiah" belonged to Raina. Shae also stated that she herself had not taken any dogs to a vet. Dane Ott advised me he would provide care for the animals on the property until Wade Ott returned. I impounded "JoJo" on Lane County Code 7.005.045 Impoundment of Animals and violation of 7.005.125 Animal Neglect that reflects ORS 167.310 regarding minimum care of animals. "JoJo" was taken to the Emergency Veterinary Hospital for immediate care regarding the injured leg, where it was determined the leg needed to be amputated, but "JoJo" was in stable condition. "JoJo" was transferred to Greenhill Humane Society where Dr. Schroeder inspected the dog and on February 2, 2024, advised me that "JoJo" had chronic scarring on leg due to disuse due to the old injury and had a malodourous dirty coat Humane Society would amputate the leg once custody of dog is decided.	•
